General Narrative Planning & Zoning Application South Meadows Multi-Use Recreational Trail Phase II East Hartford, CT

September 26, 2017

The purpose of this application is to permit the construction of an 8' wide natural trail, 2,300 feet in length, across a number of properties in East Hartford located along the east side of the Connecticut River. The East Hartford trail is part of a larger project, known as the South Meadows Multi-Use Recreational Trail Phase II (Phase II) project, which begins in East Hartford and continues through Wethersfield and into Glastonbury. A total of 7,320 feet of continuous trail for public access is proposed in the Phase II project. Ultimately, this trail will link up with the Putnam Memorial Bridge to the south and the existing trail along the Connecticut River to the north. Concrete pads for benches and informational and directional signage are proposed along the trail. Attached are details for the types of signs and benches proposed.

The proposed East Hartford trail will be constructed over 13 properties on land totaling approximately 31 acres. The proposed trail alignment will generally follow the path of an existing natural trail on the properties, except in the areas where endangered plant species or Federally Defined Wetlands are in close proximity to the trail. At these locations, the trail will be realigned to maintain a minimum separation distance from the endangered plant species and Federally Defined Wetlands as recommended by the Consulting Botanist/Plant Community Ecologist and Certified Professional Wetlands Scientist. The intent is that the trail be installed without removal of large trees (over 6" caliper) and that no clearing of vegetation beyond that required to provide the trail will be done. Generally, minor surface grading will be required to provide a level walking surface, and some clearing of vegetation, tree limbs, etc. will be required to provide a safe walking trail. The walking trail will generally follow the existing grade and will not change any drainage patterns on the properties involved. The endangered sedge and Federal Wetlands will be protected by temporary fencing during construction and Goodwin College has retained a Botanist/Plant Community Ecologist to monitor construction progress to insure that there are no impacts to the endangered sedge plants within the construction corridor.

The entire trail is located within the Flood Zone AE and within the Town Inland Wetlands. Construction will not occur during the normal flood season, and caution will be taken during construction to monitor flood conditions. A Construction Flood Contingency Plan is included in the Site Plans. Construction will also be timed to avoid work during the eagle breeding season. A complete description of the proposed erosion and sedimentation control measures and operation and maintenance schedule for the project is also included in the Site Plans.



- For surface mount option: (6) each $1/2-13 \times 1-1/2$ " hex head cap screw, drop-in anchor for 1/2-13 screw and 1/2" flat washer. Setting tool for drop-in anchor included.

Tools Required

- Safety glasses
- Hammer drill with 5/8" dia masonry drill bit (for surface mount)
- Hammer (for surface mount)

To protect this finish during assembly, place unwrapped powdercoated parts on packaging foam or other non-marring surface. Do not place or slide powdercoated parts on concrete or other hard or textured surface — this will damage the finish causing rust to occur. Use touch-up paint on any gouges in the finish caused by assembly tools.

PROCEDURE FOR INSTALLATION:

1. Prepare proper footing or slab as required.

Note: Landscape Forms is not responsible for footing or slab installation.

FOR SURFACE MOUNTED BENCH:

Note: DO NOT DRAG bench across concrete or other rough surfaces. This could damage the powdercoat on the bottom of the base plate.

- Place unit in desired position and mark anchor locations through holes provided in base plate.





Fig. 1 – Anchor Detail

- 3. Move unit and drill holes according to Fig. 1.
- 4. Clear the holes of dust and debris using compressed air.
- 5. Install drop-in anchors flush with surface of concrete.
- 6. Expand anchor with setting tool. Anchor is properly expanded when shoulder of setting tool is flush with top of anchor.
- 7. Place unit in desired position and install the washers and hex bolts. Tighten to 55-60 ft-lbs.
- 8. Periodically check fasteners and tighten if required.






MOUNTING TO NEW SLAB
