• Goodwin College Early Childhood Magnet School Expansion

MISCELLANEOUS

• Proposed Text Amendments for the August 10, 2016 meeting

Town Planner Jeff Cormier reviewed with the Commission the proposed revisions to "Places of Public Assembly" regulations and the proposed revisions to "Grocery Store/Convenience Store" regulations. "Places of Public Assembly" will be separated into two tiers, much like personal service establishments. Tier I will be commercial places of assembly, such as commercial recreation, and Tier II will be noncommercial places of assembly, such as community centers, civic clubs, etc. A definition for "Commercial Nodes" identified in the Plan of Conservation and Development will also be added to the regulations.

"Grocery Stores" and "Convenience Stores" will be differentiated by building size and new definitions will be added for each.

Regarding RV parking, it was the consensus of the Commission to move forward with revisions to the regulations dealing with the parking of RVs, boats, trailers, campers, etc. in residential zones.

IPads will be ordered after July 1st - without keyboards but with covers.
