The Consolidated Plan is a comprehensive planning document which identifies the Town's housing and non-housing community development needs. The Action Plan for FY 2015 describes activities proposed for the 2015-2016 CDBG 41<sup>st</sup> Program Year.

Priorities identified for the 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan period are:

**HOUSING PRIORITIES:**

- Improve the supply and condition of one to four unit housing occupied by low income families in designated neighborhoods and throughout East Hartford through the implementation of housing improvement programs; including but not limited to lead-based paint hazard control, general and emergency rehabilitation, handicapped accessibility, and code correction.
- Provide fair housing services to the East Hartford community including, but not limited to, education and counseling services.
- Support the continued operation of East Hartford's homeless shelter with particular emphasis on the transition of homeless persons to permanent residents in the community.

**NON-HOUSING COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PRIORITIES:**

- Support the provision of public services which include, but are not limited to, those concerned with youth services, substance abuse, senior services, and handicapped accessibility.
- Revitalization of downtown or any other area through the promotion of economic development which increases available jobs to low and moderate income persons.
- Physical improvements to parks and public facilities in deteriorating low and moderate income areas.
- Support efforts aimed at improving the physical, economic or social environment of low-moderate income neighborhoods.

This document, as well as the Action Plan, will be available for examination between June 9, 2015 and July 8, 2015. All comments will be considered through 4:30 p.m. on July 8, 2015. The Consolidated Plan is to be submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development on July 15, 2015.
