In her memory, they are donating the collection to the Library. Sarah mentioned that she plans to hold a concert in the fall in Florence's honor. Date to be determined. Sarah will propose continuing the tradition of holding a library concert in the fall that she will bring forward for Commission's funding in the future.

Sarah commented on Sustainable CT, an exciting program platform which supports a broad range of actions and supporting arts and creative culture.

The Library has decorated the Escape Room in the lower level of the library, have planned another happening from May 13 – 31, 2019, and is East Hartford History themed. Solve some puzzles, see some artifacts, and solve the mystery. This program is best suited for adults and children 8 years and up. Children under 5 years old will not be admitted. Tickets are \$10 for nonresidents. Free to East Harford residents One ticket admits up to 6 people for one session of the escape room.

On the June meeting, it is also the Library's summer reading kick off and the last week of school, Sarah reported that she will block off parking spaces for the Commission. She will send out to the Commission prior to the meeting the reserved parking spaces location.
