REGULAR MEETING MINUTES: SEPTEMBER 3, 2019

The fence is a 3.25" X 3.25" post and rail 2 rail fence, vinyl diamond, adobe in color. It will define the edge of the property line on the side and the front of the property. Mr. Simpson made a MOTION to accept Application for Certificate of Appropriateness #94 for the replacement of a wooden fence to a vinyl fence as complete; seconded by Mr. LeBeau.
