



Use a separate form to report EACH action taken by the Agency. Complete the form as described below.

Do NOT submit a reporting form for withdrawn actions.

PART I: Must Be Completed By The Inland Wetlands Agency

- 1. Choose the year and month the Inland Wetlands Agency took the action being reported. If multiple actions were taken regarding the same project or activity then multiple forms need to be completed.
- 2. Choose ONE code letter to describe the final action or decision taken by the Inland Wetlands Agency. Do NOT submit a reporting form for withdrawn actions. Do NOT enter multiple code letters (for example, if the same project or activity had both a permit issued and enforcement action, submit two forms for the two separate actions).

You MUST provide code 14 if the activity is located beyond the established upland review area or no established upland review area exists.
 - 1 = Filling

Examples: Jurisdictional ruling allowing construction of a parking lot in an upland where the municipality does not have an established upland review area must use code 14, other possible codes are 2 and 10. Permitted construction of a free standing garage (residential improvement by homeowner) partially in an established upland review area with the remainder in the upland must use code 12 and 14, other possible codes are 1 and 2.

- 11. Leave blank for TEMPORARY alterations but please indicate action/project/activity is temporary under question #8 on the form. For PERMANENT alterations, enter in acres the area of wetland soils or watercourses altered. Include areas that are permanently altered, or are proposed to be, for all agency permits, denials, amendments, renewals, jurisdictional rulings, and enforcement actions. For those activities that involve filling or dredging of lakes, ponds or similar open water bodies enter the acres filled or dredged under "open water body."
