

# > DEPARTMENT CHALLENGES



Currently 14 sworn officer vacancies

- √ Traffic Division currently has 3 officers & no supervisor
- ✓ Sergeant test under appeal
- √ Temporally disbanded VIN unit
- Hiring, training & retaining Public Safety Dispatchers
- Update all portable Police radios
- National Police legitimacy
- Marijuana legalization





#### > PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS



The Public Safety Communications Center is the main answering point for all Police, Fire and Emergency Medical calls for service within the Town of East Hartford. The Center is staffed 24 hours a day on 365 days of the year.

#### **Public Safety Communications Staffing:**

- ■1 Sworn Police Lieutenant & 4 Supervisors
- ■19 Telecommunicators

#### **Public Safety Communications Statistics:**

- ■30,555 Calls for Police Service
- ■8,008 Calls for Fire & Fire EMD
- ■1,955 Calls for Emergency Medical Service
- ■2019 Total Calls for Service 40,518
