East Hartford Silver Lane Advisory Committee to Host Public Forum

East Hartford, CT – The Town of East Hartford and the East Hartford Silver Lane Advisory Committee will host a public forum on **Tuesday, April 30, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. at East Hartford Town Hall, 740 Main Street** to obtain the public's feedback on priority goals and strategies for revitalizing the Silver Lane corridor.

The Committee has held two public forums so far, in January of 2018 and in June of 2018, which focused on collecting different perspectives on the future vision for Silver Lane. Since then, traffic and roadway existing conditions have been analyzed and future conditions have been explored. The Silver Lane Advisory Committee is now ready to present alternative roadway concepts for Silver Lane that create a safer and more vibrant corridor!
