Transfer Station and DPW Office Open Every Saturday in May for Spring Cleanup

East Hartford, CT—It has been a long time coming, but spring is finally taking over! In this season of renewal, the Town and the Department of Public Works (DPW) are asking all residents to do their part to help us keep our Town clean and beautiful through the coming summer months.

To support residential spring cleanup efforts, East Hartford Public Works will offer many resources, including educational material and will keep administrative offices and the transfer station open **every Saturday in May from 8:00 am to 1:45 pm**. These additional hours are a good opportunity for residents wishing to clean up any remaining debris from this year's winter storms or to just spend a little extra time sprucing up their properties. During these extended transfer station hours residents will be able to purchase bulky waste permits required for transfer station self-delivery and make appointments for curbside pickups on their regular collection day.

Please note, Monday, May 27 is Memorial Day holiday and trash pickup will be delayed by one day for that week.

The extended services for May are followed by a special Town-sponsored FREE paper shredding event **Saturday, June 15 from 9am-Noon. Residents can bring important paper documents for a FREE and SAFE paper shredding**, 61 Ecology Drive off of Burnside Avenue. Please follow the signs into the Town Yard. If you miss the paper shredding event in June, please note that East Hartford residents can receive free paper shredding services at EnviroShred, located at 22 Prestige Park Circle year-round with proof of East Hartford residency (ID required).
