Mayor Leclerc successfully launched a Complete Count Committee, consisting of local community members and leaders who volunteered to step forward to raise awareness about the importance of the Census with the goal to help us reach every segment of our diverse community.

The U.S. Census Bureau attempts to count every person in the United States once every decade and this valuable statistics has a direct and significant impact on federal funds allocated to municipalities. In fact, for each undercounted individual, the Town of East Hartford would lose \$2,200 in federal funds.

The 20-person committee meets on a regular basis to discuss effective ways of informing our residents about the Census and the crucial role it plays for municipalities.
