<u>Donald Sugalski</u>, 1736 Main Street, suggested that the Commission postpone action on this item and hold a public hearing after the corrected section number (711) is advertised. Mr. Sugalski also is concerned that the new regulation will allow brew pubs too close to private homes.

<u>Susan Kniep</u>, 50 Olde Roberts Street, agrees with Mr. Sugalski's comments on the legality of holding a public hearing with a different section number publicized. She asked the Commission to not go forward with this item until the legal ad has been published with section 711.
