

## RESOLUTON ADOPTING THE CAPITOL REGION NATURAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN UPDATE, 2019-2024

WHEREAS, the Town of East Hartford has historically experienced severe damage from natural hazards and it continues to be vulnerable to the effects of those natural hazards profiled in the plan (e.g. flooding, high wind, thunderstorms, winter storms, earthquakes, droughts, dam failure, and wildfires), resulting in loss of property and life, economic hardship, and threats to public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, the East Hartford Town Council approved the previous version of the Plan in 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Town of East Hartford and Capitol Region Council of Governments developed and received conditional approval from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for the Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan Update, 2019-2024 and under the requirements of 44 CFR 201.6; and

WHEREAS, public and committee meeting s were held and public input was sought in 2017 and 2018 regarding the development and review of the Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan Update, 2019-2024; and

WHEREAS, the Plan specifically addressed hazard mitigation strategies and Plan maintenance procedure for the Town of East Hartford; and

WHEREAS, the Plan recommends several hazard mitigation actions/projects that will provide mitigation for specific natural hazards that impact the Town of East Hartford, with the effect of protecting people and property from loss associated with those hazards; and

WHEREAS, adoption of this Plan will make the Town of East Hartford eligible for funding to alleviate the impacts of future hazards.

#### NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the East Hartford Town Council:

- 1. The Plan is hereby adopted as an official plan of the Town of East Hartford.
- 2. The respective officials identified in the mitigation strategy of the Plan are hereby directed to pursue implementation of the recommended actions assigned to them.
- 3. Future revisions and Plan maintenance required by 44 CFR 201.6 and FEMA are hereby adopted as a part of this resolution for a period of five years from the date of this resolution.
- 4. An annual report on the progress of the implementation elements of the Plan shall be presented to the Town Council.

<u>Bridgitte Prince</u>, 41 Bodwell Road, addressed the Council on a payment arrangement for delinquent taxes she has with the town.

Mayor Leclerc commented on: (1) the town will mill & pave Governor Street on Wednesday May 8th; (2) this summer, the town plans to mill & overlay Forbes Street, Green Manor Drive, Linwood Drive, Montclair Drive, Jarman Drive, Timber Trail, Tolland Street and, if finances allow, Maple Street, Mitchell Drive and Wadsworth Street; (3) the town plans a full reclamation of Cambridge Drive, Evans Avenue, Handel Road, Hollister Drive, Jefferson Lane, Milbrook Drive, Nassau Circle, Oxford Drive, Princeton Lane and Sutton Avenue. The Mayor indicated that the new standards for the road program will include the installation of new curbing, stop signs and street signs. (4) the Mayor's Clean-up Day is May 18th; (5) the low cost rabies clinic will be held on Saturday, May 18th behind the Fire House, 726 Main Street (next to Town Hall); (6) the transfer station at Ecology Drive will be opened every Saturday in May; (7) Subway is sponsoring Sandwich with a Cop, 1210 Main Street on Tuesday May 21st; (8) the Veterans Commission will be adding the name of Allen W. Eckert, a WWII US Army soldier to the Gold Star Honor Roll at Bicentennial Park on Sunday May 26th; and (9) on Thursday May 23rd, the Veterans Commission will be hosting a musical program to honor veterans in the auditorium of East Hartford High School.

Attached is a draft resolution endorsing the Town's proposed 45th Program Year Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Action Plan for the period September 1, 2019 through August 31, 2020. The Town's allocation for this time period is estimated at \$555,818.

The activities chosen for funding in the proposed Action Plan reflect community development needs, citizen comments received at three public hearings, and the objectives of our Consolidated Plan. Per Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requirements, notices regarding the proposed Action Plan were printed in The Hartford Courant on October 23, 2018, December 11, 2018, March 1, 2019, and April 9, 2019.
