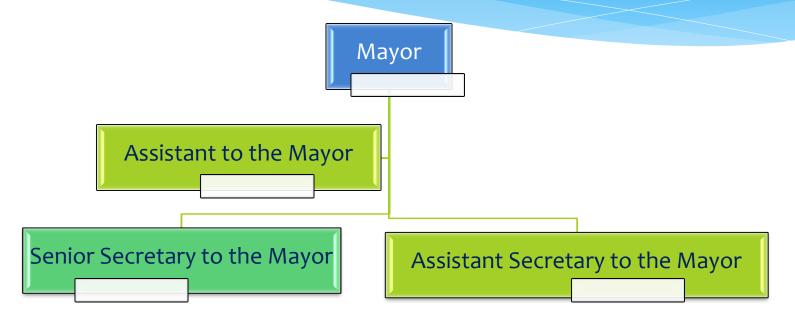

- The Mayor's office serves as a "clearing house" facilitating immediate responses to requests for information and assistance, as well as the satisfactory resolution of complaints
