#### **APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES**

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

A. File #2020-22, Application of The Metropolitan District to conduct a regulated activity in an Inland Wetlands Upland Review area in conjunction with the installation of a new water main in Cummings Street and Walnut Street

Cmsr. Rivera moved to <u>**REMOVE**</u> the application from the table. Cmsr. Roczynski seconded All in Favor; None Opposed; None Abstained

Guy Russo of Prime Engineering and Frank Cahill of MDC spoke on behalf of the application.

Cmsr. Rivera moved to <u>APPROVE</u> the application with the following conditions:

- 1. The permit is non-transferable without the written consent of the Town of East Hartford Inland Wetlands Environment Commission.
- 2. Soil sedimentation and erosion controls acceptable to the Town Engineer are to be maintained at all times.
- 3. All work in the Inland Wetlands and/or Inland Wetland Upland Review Area shall be commenced within five (5) years from the effective date. The activity shall be completed within one (1) year from the commencement of the activity.
- 4. Written notice shall be submitted to the Town Engineer 48 hours prior to the starting date of the approved activity.

- 5. In evaluating this application, the Inland Wetlands Environment Commission has relied on information provided by the applicant, and if such information subsequently proves to be false, deceptive, incomplete and/or inaccurate, this permit shall be modified, suspended, or revoked.
- 6. Approval is granted based on the maps submitted with the application with plans dated December 8, 2020.

B. File #21-02, Application of the Greater Hartford Transit Districtto conduct a regulated activity in an Inland Wetlands and Inland Wetlands Upland Review area in conjunction with the construction of a parking lot at 144-148 Roberts Street.

Cmsr. Rivera moved to <u>**REMOVE**</u> the application from the table. Cmsr. Roczynski seconded All in Favor; None Opposed; None Abstained

Sebastian Amenta of Comprehensive Environmental Inc. spoke on behalf of the application.

Cmsr. Rivera moved to <u>APPROVE</u> the application with the following conditions:
