## **NEW BUSINESS**

ACCEPT AS COMPLETE: APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF
APPROPRIATENESS FOR 219 NAUBUC AVENUE (OWNER: GONSLAVES) #84 –
REMOVE AND REPLACE EXISTING GARAGE: Mr. Gonsalves wishes to remove and replace the deteriorating garage structure with a new outbuilding in the same footprint as the old outbuilding. The new outbuilding will be larger and have a gambrel roof rather that a gable roof which was on the old outbuilding. The site plan has the outbuilding 20 feet from the rear (north) of the property line and 15 feet from the west side of the property line. After a long discussion by Commission members, Mr. Cummings made a MOTION to accept application #84 for 219 Naubuc Avenue as complete with the following amendments – the outbuilding will be 36' x 36' instead of the dimensions on the application, the shiplap wood siding will be vertical rather than horizontal, material samples will be presented at the next meeting including shiplap wood siding, shingles, copper flashings and window

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specifications. Also, a letter from the Zoning department is requested stating the proper dimensions for the roof line; seconded by Mr. Spence. Vote was unanimous and uncontested.

<u>NOTICE OF INTENT TO DEMOLISH – 187 ROBERTS STREET</u>: Mr. O'Sullivan presented the letter to the Commission. A brief discussion followed.
