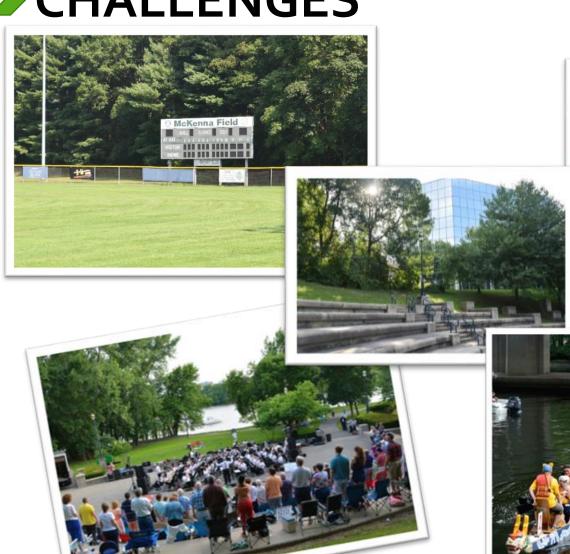
> HOLD THE LINE ON SPENDING

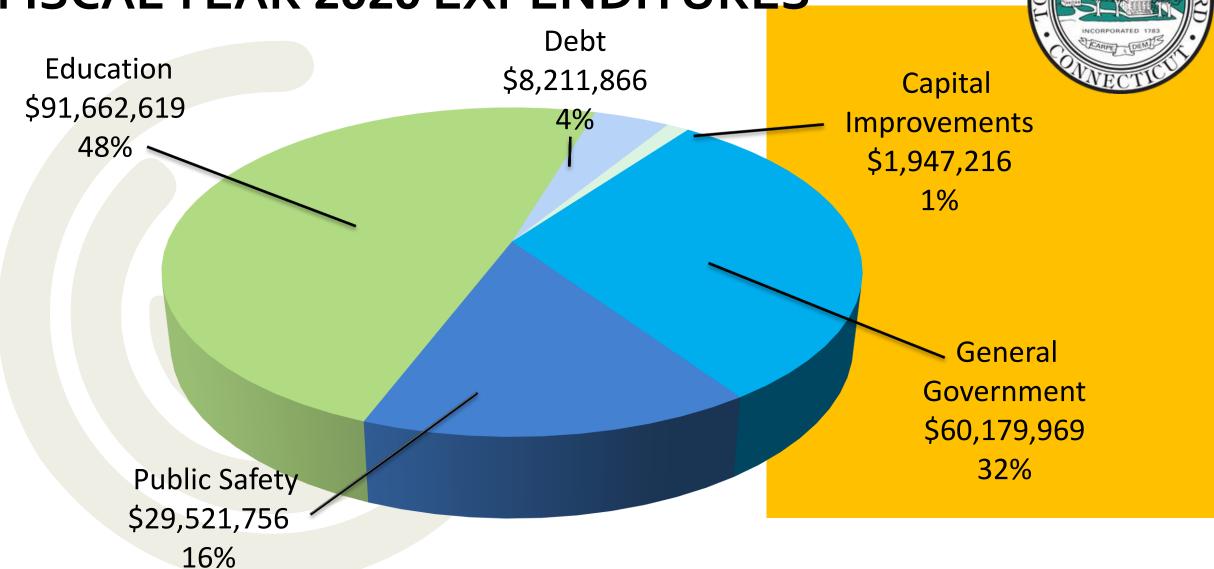


> CAPITAL INVESTMENT

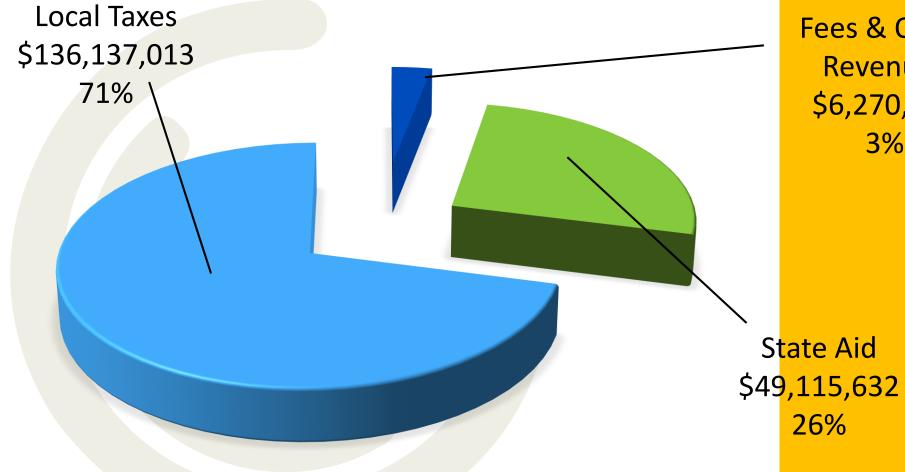




> FISCAL YEAR 2020 EXPENDITURES
