Greetings Future Vendor/ Crafter,

The Town of East Hartford would like to welcome you to join us for the **Juneteenth Family Celebration scheduled for Saturday, June 17th from 11:00am—4:00pm on the East Hartford Town Green (50 Chapman Place)**. According to the 2020 Census Report, East Hartford is ranked second as the most diverse town in Connecticut. We expect this event to be one of our biggest family event of the season for everyone. On this day of Recognition, Restoration and Celebration as a town embrace our uniqueness and enrichment with crafters, entertainment, carnival games, inflatables, face painting, and many other family oriented activities.

Crafters, Vendors and Non-Profit Community Groups are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Spaces are marked on a grassy area along the walkway of the Town Green. Electricity is not available. **Vendors are responsible for providing their own table, chairs, and canopy tents** as well as responsible for securing those tents and all property/merchandise from wind or inclement weather. Any display, merchandise, or tables/chairs must be within the space perimeters and may not extend into the walkways or another adjacent space. Single spaces are 10 feet by 10 feet. Vendors are required to stay for the full duration of the event and will not be allowed to leave the grounds for the safety of our patrons until after the event has concluded.

Space fees are non-refundable. Full payment must accompany the completed application form (See back for more information.) In the event of inclement weather, the event will be held on Sunday, June 18th instead, same location and time. All vendors must be able to commit to both the event and rain date to be considered as a 2023 vendor/ crafter. We look forward to reviewing your application and seeing you at the event!
