

MONKEYPOX VACCINATION



WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

The CDC does not recommend widespread vaccination against monkeypox at this time. However, vaccination may be recommended for some people who:

- Are closer personal contacts of people with monkeypox
- May have been exposed to the virus
- May have increased risk of being exposed to the virus due to occupation

Vaccine is also available to people who meet <u>all</u> of the following conditions:

- Gay, bisexual, or other man who has sex with men, and/or transgender, gender nonconforming, or gender non-binary
- Have had multiple or anonymous sex partners in the last 14 days
- Age 18 or older
- Connecticut resident, regardless of immigration status

INSURANCE NOT REQUIRED. PAYMENT NOT REQUIRED.

For those who meet the eligibility requirements, the vaccine will be available at the following local community-based health centers by appointment only:
