CAR BATTERIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Safely carry in vehicle
CLOTHING TEXTILES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Used clothing footwear, bedding, linens, hats, gloves, etc. or deliver to Senior Center thrift shop "It's New to You"
ELECTRONICS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • TVs, computers, monitor's VCR/DVD players, cameras, keyboards, microwaves, etc.
GRASS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In brown paper bags only. NO plastic bags allowed
LEAVES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In brown paper bags or loose only. NO plastic bags allowed
MATTRESSES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mattresses and box springs
PAINTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Latex and oil based paints, deck coating, primers, sealers, stains, shellacs, lacquers, metal coatings, rust preventatives, lawn paints in originals cans
