- ARPA reallocations initially planned for this meeting's agenda have been removed. One of the items, a project to redevelop the Golf Course restaurant building porch into a three season room had originally been estimated at \$125,000 but actual bids were more than \$250,000. After meeting with management of the facility, the Mayor feels that other capital improvements to the course may be a higher priority. The Administration will continue to review options with a goal of seeking Town Council approval for a complete set of reallocations at the next regular council meeting.
- Shared renderings of planned short term improvements for the revitalization of Bissell Street. With the potential closure of the street, plans for traffic reconfiguration are underway. The Mayor's goal is to close the road by July 1 so summer entertainment events can be held at that site.
